This action addresses an accusation filed on September 12, 2023 by the Air Pollution Control Officer ("APCO") of the Monterey Bay Air Resources District ("MBARD"), Petitioner in this action, against LOVESWORTH, INC. a 16 California Corporation, doing business as ("d/b/a") FIRST STOP & GO VALERO, a Gasoline Dispensing Facility ("GDF"); and SAMUEL EZEIBE, an individual, also 18 d/b/a FIRST STOP & GO VALERO (hereinafter "Respondents"), seeking an order 19 for abatement requiring Respondents to cease operation of the GDF located at 20 3304 Del Monte Blvd, Marina, Monterey County, unless Respondents complied 21 with the requirements of MBARD Rules 200.3.2 and 300.5.1.6. 22

NOTICE OF HEARING AND PROCEEDINGS

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The Clerk of the Hearing Board assigned this matter Docket No. 23-005 and set public hearing on the petition for Order for Abatement for October 13, 2023. The Clerk of the Hearing Board provided notice of the hearing in accordance with the requirements of Health and Safety Code Section 40823.

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The Hearing Board conducted a public hearing on October 13, 2023.
 Richard A. Stedman, APCO appeared for Petitioner. None of the Respondents
 appeared.

Because Respondents did not file a notice of defense, Respondents'
express admissions may be used as evidence without any notice of thereof, and
the Hearing Board may decide the matter or dismiss the action at the public
hearing, pursuant to MBARD Regulation VI Hearing Board Rules.

Petitioner made an opening statement and submitted additional exhibits into the record. The Hearing Board entered Petitioner's exhibits 8 and 9 into the record.

The Hearing Board Chair opened the hearing to members of the public for comments. There were no public comments.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Following discussion, the Hearing Board made the following findings: 1. Respondents own or operate the facility, a gasoline dispensing facility located at 3304 Del Monte Blvd., Marina, Monterey County; and

2. Respondents know of their requirement to hold such a permit in order to conduct their gasoline dispensing operations; and

3. Respondents failed to pay the outstanding permit renewal fees and since May 2022, have been operating and continue to operate the facility without a current or valid permit.

 Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 42451(a), the Hearing Board finds:

The Respondent is in violation of MBARD Rules 200.3.2 and 300.5.1.6.

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CONDITIONAL ORDER FOR ABATEMENT 1 Pursuant to Sections 42451(a) and 42452 of the California Health and 2 Safety Code, THE HEARING BOARD of the MONTEREY BAY AIR RESOURCES DISTRICT 3 hereby ORDERS: 4 1. That on or before 30 days from the Effective Date of this Conditional 5 Order for Abatement, Respondents, and their agents, employees, 6 successors and assigns, shall cease gasoline dispensing operation at 7 3304 Del Monte Blvd., Marina, Monterey County, California, until they 8 come into compliance with MBARD Rules 200.3.2 and 300.5.1.6., by 9 payment of outstanding permit renewal fees in the amount of \$6,141.00; 10 and 11 2. That on or before 30 days from the Effective Date of this Conditional 12 Order for Abatement, Respondents, and their agents, employees, 13 successors and assigns, shall cease gasoline dispensing operation at 14 3304 Del Monte Blvd., Marina, Monterey County, California, until they 15 come into compliance with MBARD Rules 200.3.2 and 300.5.1.6., by 16 providing a new application for a Permit to Operate and payment of the 17 application fees in the amount of \$1,769.00; and 18 3. That the Hearing Board shall retain jurisdiction over the conditional 19 order for abatement until April 13, 2023. If compliance is not achieved 20 by April 13, 2023, this Order shall expire if not properly extended; 21 and 22 4. That this Conditional Order for Abatement shall take effect on the date 23 the Hearing Board causes this Order to be filed ("Effective Date"), 24 pursuant to Hearing Board Rule Part 8. 25 11 26 27 11 28 11



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

24	1. MBARD is and has been	n organized and existing under Chapter					
25	4 of Part 3 of Division 26 (sect	ions 40100 to 40276) of the California					
26	Health and Safety Code. MBARD i	s and has been a governmental agency					
27	charged with the primary respons	ibility for controlling air pollution					
28	from all sources other than moto	r vehicles, which responsibility					
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includes adopting an enforcing rules and regulations relating to air pollution and maintaining healthy air quality in Monterey, Santa Cruz and San Benito counties.

2. The APCO is appointed by the MBARD Board of Directors ("MBARD Board") and authorized to enforce all orders, rules and regulations adopted or prescribed by MBARD Board. *California Health and Safety (H&S) Code Sections 40750 and 40752*. The APCO is authorized to seek an order for abatement from MBARD's Hearing Board to stop violations of an MBARD rule or regulation. *H&S Code Section 42451(a)*.

10 Respondents and the Facility

3. FIRST STOP & GO VALERO ("FIRST STOP & GO VALERO), is a gasoline dispensing facility ("GDF") located at 3044 Del Monte Blvd., Marina, Monterey County, California, and is subject to the jurisdiction of MBARD. The facility is comprised of two underground gasoline storage tanks and four gasoline dispensers with eight nozzles.

4. LOVESWORTH HOLDINGS, INC. ("LOVESWORTH HOLDINGS") is a California corporation, which MBARD understands and believes, and thereon alleges, does business as FIRST STOP & GO VALERO. LOVESWORTH HOLDINGS'S business address is 3044 Del Monte Blvd., Marina, California. The president of LOVESWORTH HOLDINGS is SAMUEL EZEIBE. SAMUEL EZEIBE is listed in MBARD's records as the facility's contact.

5. Petitioner is informed and believes and thereon alleges that SAMUEL EZEIBE owns and/or operates the facility and the real property at which the facility is located and has owned and/or operated the facility and the real property at which the facility is located, at all times relevant to this matter.

MBARD Hearing Board

6. MBARD's Hearing Board may, after notice and a hearing, issue an order for abatement against Respondents when the Hearing Board finds that a respondent is operating any equipment or other contrivance without a permit to operate in violation of an MBARD rule or regulation. *H&S Code Section 42451(a)*. The Hearing Board's order will require a respondent either to refrain from a particular act or to refrain from a particular act unless certain conditions are met. *H&S Code Section 42452*.

10 Gasoline Emits Volatile Organic Compounds and Toxic Air Contaminants

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7. Gasoline is a complex mixture of multiple substances. Gasoline emits volatile organic compounds ("VOCs") which are organic compounds that evaporate quickly into the atmosphere. VOCs, reacting with oxides of nitrogen in sunlight, create ground level ozone. Ground level ozone is the primary component of photochemical smog, which is a significant air quality problem. Ozone aggravates respiratory diseases and damages vegetation.

 Currently, MBARD is designated as attainment with both the state and federal ambient air quality standards for ozone.

9. Gasoline also contains toxic air contaminants. A toxic air contaminant is defined as an air pollutant which may cause or contribute to an increase in mortality, an increase in serious illness, or which may pose a present or potential hazard to human health. H&S Code Section 39655(a). Examples of toxic air contaminants in gasoline are benzene, ethyl benzene, n-hexane, propylene, naphthalene, xylenes, and toluene.

10. State law and MBARD Rules 418 and 1002 require vapor control for gas stations to reduce VOC and toxic air contaminant

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emissions. These requirements are included as conditions in a permit to operate issued by MBARD.

MBARD RULE 200.3.2 AND RULE 300.5.1.6

11. One of MBARD's means to control VOC emissions from GDFs is the requirement that GDF owners or operators obtain a Permit to Operate to use or operate gasoline dispensing equipment at their GDFs. This authorization allows MBARD to ensure that only approved equipment is used, and to identify and impose any conditions, limitations, and restrictions to the operation of that equipment that are necessary to minimize emissions. The authorization and permitting requirements are found in MBARD Rule 200. Specifically, Rule 200.3.2 prohibits the use or operation of any article, machine, equipment, or other contrivance that causes or controls the issuance of air contaminants – including air contaminants such as gasoline vapors – by any person (as described in MBARD Rule 200) without first obtaining a written authorization from the APCO in the form of a permit to operate. *MBARD Rule 200*.

12. A permit to operate is valid for 12 months (or other period authorized by the APCO). *MBARD Rule 300.5.1.6*. After the initial permit to operate is issued, the GDF must renew the permit to operate on an annual basis and pay associated permit fees pursuant to *MBARD Rule 300*. Annual permit fees for gasoline dispensing facilities are calculated following Rule 300.4.6 and are based upon the number of nozzles, whether the system is balance or assist, and the annual gasoline throughput.

13. MBARD assesses late fees at various intervals when annual permit renewal fees remain unpaid 60 days after the original invoice date. MBARD Rule 300 Part 5.

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Respondents Violated MBARD Rule 200.3.2 and Rule 300.5.1.6

14. Petitioner is informed and believes, and thereon alleges, that Respondents have owned and/or operated the GDF since on or about June 13, 2019.

- 15. The MBARD permit to operate for the GDF renews on December 21 each year.
- 16. Respondents have not had a current, valid permit to operate since May 20, 2022 when the permit expired for non-payment of annual renewal fees.
- 17. On or about December 31, 2021, MBARD sent Respondents an invoice to renew Permit to Operate No. GNR-0018010, in the amount of \$4,094.00, due within 60 days. No payment was received. A true and correct copy of Invoice No. 4095-12302021 is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 1.
- 18. On or about March 9, 2022, MBARD, in accordance with MBARD Rule 300.5.1.2, issued a second invoice, which included the delinquency penalty amount. The total amount due to renew the Permit to Operate was \$5,117.50. A true and correct copy of Invoice No. 4095-030922 is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 2.
- 19. On or about April 8, 2022, MBARD, in accordance with MBARD Rule 300.5.1.4, issued a third invoice, which included the second delinquency penalty amount. The total amount due to renew the Permit to Operate was \$6,141.00. A true and correct copy of Invoice No. 4095-040822 is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 3.

20. On or about May 20, 2022, MBARD sent correspondence, in accordance with Rule 300.5.1.6, which indicated that Permit to Operate

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No. GNR-0018010, has been expired due to non-payment. It was noted that further operation of the subject equipment without a valid permit is prohibited. A true and correct letter regarding the expiration is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 4.

21. On or about June 22, 2022, MBARD inspected the GDF and observed that gasoline dispensing operations continued without a valid Permit to Operate, in violation of MBARD Rule 200. MBARD issued Notice of Violation ("NOV") No. NOV-22-020 for operation of the GDF without a valid Permit to Operate. A true and correct copy of NOV-22-020 is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 5.

22. On or about November 15, 2022, MBARD issued a settlement offer for NOV-22-020 which provided directions on how to reinstate Permit to Operate GNR-0018010. A true and correct copy of Settlement Offer for NOV-22-020 is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 6.

23. On June 14, 2023, MBARD's Supervising Compliance Inspector, Teresa Sewell, visited Respondents' gas station. The gas station was still open and operating to dispense gasoline. An employee helped Ms. Sewell reach Samuel Ezeibe by phone, as he was not present at the gas station. Samuel Ezeibe stated he would come to MBARD office June 15, 2023. Samuel Ezeibe did appear at MBARD's office on this date.

24. On or about July 14, 2023, MBARD's Counsel Leslie J. Girard, mailed a certified letter to Respondent, regarding operation without a valid permit to operate. A true and correct copy of Certified Mail Letter from MBARD Counsel Leslie J. Girard is attached to this Accusation and Petition for Order for Abatement as Exhibit 7.

25. On numerous occasions, MBARD has notified Respondents that the facility has been operating without a valid Permit to Operate. Respondents' History of Non-Compliance

26. In December of 2020, Respondents were sent a renewal invoice in the amount of \$4,015. As this was not paid a late invoice was issued in the amount of \$5,018.00. Respondents' account was brought into good standing on March 26, 2021.

27. In February of 2022, during an inspection, MBARD issued Notice to Comply for failure to comply with Permit to Operate Conditions 4a, b, c, 5, & 10; during inspection no Phase I, II, Quarterly Inspections, maintenance, repair, and ISD alarm records available.

28. MBARD is informed and believes, and thereon alleges, that given Respondents' history with MBARD's rules and regulations -notably, Respondents' failure to maintain a valid Permit to Operate -Respondents will not bring the facility into compliance with MBARD rules and regulations without an order issued by the Hearing Board that Respondents cease and desist operation until Respondents do so.

29. Accordingly, by this Accusation, the APCO seeks an Order for Abatement that requires Respondents to cease violating MBARD Rule 200.3.2 immediately by ceasing gasoline fueling operations at the facility until Respondents obtain a valid MBARD Permit to Operate in compliance with all applicable MBARD rules and regulations.

30. It is not unreasonable to require Respondents to comply with MBARD Rule 200.3.2.

SUBJECT: Violation of Operating Without a Valid Permit to Operate (NOV-22-020)

Dear Mr. Ezeibe:

The Permit to Operate issued by the Monterey Bay Air Resources District (MBARD) for your gas station located at 3044 Del Monte Blvd, Marina expired on May 20, 2022. The gas station has been operating without a valid permit for over a year. I have advised MBARD to take legal action if you do not resolve this matter by July 14, 2023. According to MBARD Rule 200 and Health and Safety Code Section 42300, an MBARD Permit to Operate is required for businesses that dispense gasoline.

In a letter dated November 15, 2022, MBARD sent you a penalty settlement offer in the amount of \$8,075 to bring your gas station into compliance. MBARD has tried numerous times to reach you via phone, email, and in person at the gas station to settle this matter. You have not been responsive to all of these attempts to contact you.

On June 14, 2023, Teresa Sewell, MBARD Supervising Air Quality Compliance Inspector, visited your gas station. Although you were not present during her visit, one of your employees helped Ms. Sewell reach you by phone and you stated you would come to the MBARD office on June 15, 2023. As promised, you did not appear at MBARD's office on that date.

Please be advised that MBARD will take legal action to close your fueling operations at the gas station and collect any past-due permit fees and penalties. To

avoid this legal action, you must resolve this matter by paying outstanding penalties and fees and have your expired Permit to Operate reinstated.
