Notification of Effective Date for ICC Certification of Gasoline Facility Installers

Notification of Enhanced Vapor Recovery and ICC Certification Test Workshop

District Rules 418 and 1002 require that no later than six months after the final acceptance of the ICC Vapor Recovery Installation Certification exam, vapor recovery installation personnel must have current ICC Vapor Recovery Installation Certification. The District has found that the test is now readily accepted and available and that no later than May 1, 2008 vapor recovery installation personnel must have current ICC Vapor Recovery Certification. Additional information on ICC Certification and a summary of certification requirements is attached.

District Rules and State regulations also require that all gasoline dispensing facilities complete the installation of Phase II (filling of vehicles) Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) upgrades by April 1, 2009.

To ensure that gasoline dispensing facility owners and contractors who install vapor recovery systems understand these requirements, the District will be holding a workshop regarding EVR and ICC Certification Testing. If you have not already fulfilled these requirements it is highly recommended that you attend this workshop. The workshop agenda is attached.
